## Advanced Standing Requirements for BS in Industrial Engineering Catalogs: Fall 2012 – Present

Advanced Standing requires successful completion of courses listed in the freshman and sophomore curricula, with at least 12 units completed at the University of Arizona and a minimum 2.0 gpa. The following course work must be completed to achieve Advanced Standing in Industrial Engineering:

- A. English Composition Requirement complete one of the following:
  - 1. ENGL 101 or ENGL 107 -AND-

ENGL 102 or ENGL 108

-OR-

ENGL 109H

- B. Mathematics:
  - 1. 1 course from: MATH 122A/B, 124, 125
  - 2. MATH 129
  - 3. MATH 223
- C. Chemistry:
  - 1. CHEM 151
  - 2. 1 course from MSE 110 or CHEM 152
- D. Physics:
  - 1. PHYS 141
  - 2. PHYS 241
- E. Engineering Sciences:
  - 1. ENGR 102 (or approved substitute course)
  - 2. 1 course from CSC 127A or ECE 175 or CSC 110
  - 3. 1 course from AME 230, CE 214, ECE 207, ECE 220 or CHEE 201
- F. Industrial Engineering (must have grade of C or better):
  - 1. SIE 250
  - 2. SIE 265
  - 3. SIE 270
  - 4. SIE 277
  - 5. SIE 295S

Students who transfer all or some courses for Advanced Standing will receive temporary Advanced Standing until they complete 4 engineering courses (12 units) at UA.
